Annual Golf Tournament Rules

Registering to play as a team or as an individual means that you have read and agree to abide by these rules

- 1. Men and women participating in the tournament must tee off from the markers designated by the Tournament Director and assigned the day of the event.
- 2. After all 4 players have hit off the tee, the group will select the best ball and take their next stroke from within a clublength of the selected ball. NOTE: Ball hazards stay in hazards. Balls are placed (not dropped) within one club-length of selected ball.
- 3. Repeat process until reaching the putting green. On the green the group will play from the original spot of the best green shot (not within a club-length or head length) and play until holed out. Continue process on all 18 holes.
- 4. Mulligans will be on sale, but may not be used on any contest hole. No players may use more than 1 mulligan per hole. Mulligans must be filled out completely and turned in with score card.
- 5. No pros, former pros, non-sponsored, under 18, or unregistered player may compete on contest holes. Under no circumstances will any player be allowed to take more than one shot on contest holes.
- 6. One shot from each player in the group must be counted once on the front 9 holes and once on the back 9 holes.
- 7. Score cards will be turned in within 10 minutes of completing final hole. Gross score only (no handicap). There will be no exceptions made.
- 8. Threesomes must play as foursomes. Players must alternate missing player's turn. Play must be arranged so players do not take consecutive shots. Missing player's stroke cannot be used for contest holes. No second shot will be allowed for any contest hole for any reason by any player.
- 9. All issues, matters or other points covered or not covered by these rules will be decided by the Tournament Director and the Director's decision will be final. Any disputes, issues, or other problems will be taken to the Tournament Director for resolution. The Tournament Director has the authority to make any decision to allow for fair play and consistent rules. There will be no appeal for a decision made by the Tournament Director.
